## Meet Conditions:

1. Meet will be swum under SNZ/FINA rules.
2. This meet is open to all financial SNZ registered competitive or club swimmers.
3. Age as at 29 October 2017.
4. Self-marshalling will operate for all events except for Event 3.
5. During warmup, lanes 0-9 will be for general swimming with no diving for the first 20mins, after which lanes 9,8,1,0 will become sprint lanes with diving, **EXCEPT** that if required, lane 9 will be reserved for Para swimmers only throughout the warmup.
6. Swimmers may enter up to 3 events, and **No Times** will be accepted. All events will be swum as timed finals.
7. Entry fees \$20 meet fee per swimmer for 1-3 individual events. Mystery sprints and Relay are free. Entries and payment will be via the SNZ Database.
8. Mystery Sprints - All swimmers can choose to swim this event. Details for this event will be provided on the day, and limited to 3 heats.
9. Escalator Relay— club teams of 7 swimmers all swimming freestyle (400M). 1st swimmer—25m 2nd— 50m, 3rd—75m, 4th—100m, 5th—75m, 6th—50m, 7th—25m. Relay entries to be completed by the Club Administrator.
10. Entries open on 1 October 2017 and close at **Midnight (11:59:59)** on **Tuesday 24 October 2017**. Late entries will not be accepted.
11. There will be no refunds for withdrawals once psych sheets are released on Wednesday 25 October 2017.
12. Programmes \$2. Spectators \$2 **NO EFTPOS, CASH ONLY, SWIMMERS AND OFFICIALS MUST USE THEIR SWN ENTRY CARD**
13. All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules.
14. Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet and shall compete under the IPC swimming rules. Para swimmers must present their classification card to the Referee at the commencement of the meet.
15. **By entering this meet, swimmers agree to allow images (e.g. photography, video, etc.) to be taken by accredited media approved by Swimming Wellington. Images are only to be used for legitimate purposes by Swim Wellington in accordance with the SNZ Member Protection Policy.**
16. All clubs must undertake the Duty Club positions as listed below.
17. Swimming Wellington reserves the right to restrict entries, combine events or alter the programme.
18. Swimming Wellington will not be liable for any loss, damage or injury that may occur at this meet.
19. Participating Clubs are to provide officials as requested by RTOP over and above the Duty Club requirements.
