## Conditions of Entry

1. Meet will be swum under SNZ /FINA rules.
2. Age is as at 18<sup>th</sup> June 2017. The Championships are open to all fully paid-up financial members of Tawa Swimming Club.
3. NT (No Times) are accepted for all events. There is no restriction on the number of events entered, but swimmers must only enter events in their age group.
4. Pool entry will be payable at the door.
5. All events will be swum as timed finals, with results contributing to the Age Groups points and/or the Cups and Trophies as listed:  
(<http://www.swimtawa.org.nz/clubtrophies.php>).
6. Please refer to the trophy list to see which events are swum for age group trophies.
7. All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules.
8. Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet and shall compete under the IPC Swimming Rules. Para swimmers must present their classification card to the Meet Director prior to the commencement of the meet.
9. Tawa Swimming Club reserves the right to restrict entries, combine events or alter the programme.
10. Entries will be via the SNZ Database. Entries close at 23:59.59 (midnight) on Saturday 10th June 2017 – late entries will not be accepted.
11. Participants who have entered this event agree to allow images (e.g. photography, video, etc.) to be taken by accredited media approved by Swimming Wellington. Images are only to be used for legitimate purposes by Swimming Wellington or host Club in accordance with the SNZ Member Protection Policy.
12. All swimmers entering this meet must provide an official or person to assist with running the meet as required.
13. Senior officials are asked to advise Hugh Allan of their availability by 12 June 2017.
14. Tawa Swimming Club will not be liable for any loss, damage or injury that may occur at this meet.
15. Family relay must consist of 3 people from two generations, i.e 2 swimmers, 1 parent or 2 parents, 1 swimmer (25m each swimmer).

## Scoring System

Points will be awarded as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> place = 6 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> place = 4 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> place = 2 points, in the following age groups:

- Senior Years Girls & Boys

NB: All Open events (12\* & 23\*) are non-championship; No points are awarded.
